Operations and Maintenance:

1. Custodian and maintenance training
2. Periodic surveillance of ACBM condition
3. Labeling in routine maintenance areas
4. Tri-annual reinspections and update

Custodial and Maintenance Classification:

1. Asbestos Aware (OSHA class IV)
 - 2 hours of initial training plus annual refresher
 - General information about asbestos, its uses in buildings, health risks
 - Will not disturb ACBM in performance of job
2. O&M Qualified (OSHA class III)
 - 16 hours of training each year
 - Detailed information about asbestos, its uses in buildings, health risks
 - Training in proper work practices and respiratory protection
 - May disturb small amounts of ACBM in performance of job

Asbestos-Containing floor Tile Maintenance:

1. Stripping must be (a) wet, (B) using least abrasive pad that will work, (c) rotated no faster than 300 rpm.
2. High speed dry buffing allowed only if there is sufficient finish coat to prevent direct contact with floor material
3. Sanding, saw cutting, and drilling are not allowed.

BOARD OF EDUCATION

ELLSWORTH MEMORIAL BUILDING

1. Floor tile and mastic throughout building
2. Pipe insulation in offices, gym and lower level
3. Pipe fitting insulation in basement store rooms
4. Transite on attic door

SOUTH WINDSOR HIGH SCHOOL

1. Floor tile and mastic in selected areas (under some carpets also)
2. Pipe fitting insulation above main level ceiling and on roof drain bowls

TIMOTHY EDWARDS MIDDLE SCHOOL

1. Brown glue daubs behind white boards in rooms S102, 135, 211-214, 261-264, 301-303, 311-314, 361-364, 371-373
2. Floor tile in lower level art storage room (M104)

WAPPING ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

1. Floor tile and mastic in halls and some rooms except room 56 (under carpet most areas)
2. Pipe insulation above and below stage
